

## Artist's Logbook

Activity Name: Tigers in the park!

### Instructions

#### You will need:

- **Green paper** (white paper works to)
- **Orange paper** (or paint an orange circle)
- A **cup** or beaker
- **Safety scissors**
- **Green, orange, blue paint.** (or any colour you would like to use.)
- **Paint brushes,** water and a palette.
- A **black felt tip pen** or pencil.

#### How to:

1. **Visit a park** or garden to **collect some leaves.** (Stay away from trees or bushes with berries and nettles)
2. Decide **which paint colours to use.**
3. **Paint the veiny/raised back** of the leaf.
4. **Press the leaf onto the paper.** (Green or white paper)
5. **you can paint over the edges of the leaf in a different colour,** making a brush marked outline.
6. Remove the leaf from the paper.
7. Re-use and **paint more leaves to cover the paper.**
8. Leave the printing to dry.
9. **Make a tiger!** (using either the orange paper or by painting or colouring in a circle)
10. Use your **cup** to draw around and **make a circle.**
11. **Draw two triangles at the top of the circle** to make ears and make two smaller black triangles inside.
12. **Use the black pen** to draw on the tiger face and markings. (Stripes)
13. **Cut out your tiger head** and place on the background when its dry.
