Activity Name: Window poem

Instructions

You will need:

A roll of masking tape
A pen or pencil
Scrap paper
Your imagination...
A window!

How to

1. On a piece of paper write lots of different random things - animals, vegetables and everyday objects (at least 20) e.g. crocodile, potatoes, mugs
2. On another piece of paper, write a list of 6 things you can see out of your window e.g. hedge, tree, washing line...
3. Pair up each of the things from outside your window with something from your first list such as hedge/crocodile
4. You will make each pair into a line for your poem. E.g. *The hedge creeps by the garden like a hungry crocodile.*
5. Stick strips of masking tape on the window and write a line of your poem on each piece.
6. You can move the lines around to decide on the order.
7. Take a photo of your window poem to share with your friends and family.
