Things to stick with:

string, blu tak, cling
film, tin foil, pegs,
strong glue (you don't
need all of these, just
some of them, so find
which things you
have!)

Imagination

How to:

1. Collect any broken toys or games that you have together.
2. Bring broken pieces from different toys or games together to create new characters, new games or even sculptures!
3. Think carefully about whether you want to permanently join your pieces together. If not, can you balance them, slot them together or use a temporary 'glue' like blu tak, cling film, tin foil, pegs from the washing line or string/wool to tie things together.
4. If you want to join them together permanently, think about the best way to do this – it will depend on the surface, or texture, of your toy and game parts. Tape sticks plastic, wood and card and glue sticks stick paper or card and materials that aren't too fluffy. To join some materials together, the best option might be stronger glue (ask for help from an adult).
